
## LGBTQ in the 21st Century

"This volume brings together thirty-four texts drawn from print publications, media sources (NPR, PBS, etc.) and several websites.

The items are grouped into five key sections: LGBTQ and the Law, LGBTQ and the World, LGBTQ Culture, LBGTQ in the Schools, and LGBTQ and the Family. The sources range from the conservative "Daily Signal" to more liberal publications and media. The topics are very wide-ranging, from a debate in Minnesota as to whether kindergarten children should be taught about gender identity, to an examination of the current status of the LGBTQ community in the Middle East and to the torture of gays in Chechnya. Texts also explore the history the LGBTQ world, from ancient Greece to the present.

A list of nine websites includes both pro- and antigay groups, while the bibliography brings together often useful references found in the six introductory texts (a preface and five section introductions) written by Micah L. Issitt... Given that this topic is one of frequent discussion in many venues, from national publications and news outlets to schools and colleges, libraries of all kinds should consider adding it to their collections."
