
## Famous First Facts About American Politics

Categories are arranged alphabetically, and all entries included therein are listed chronologically. Subject, year, personal name, and geographic location indexes make finding the material easier still, though likely not as easily located as searching electronically. Users can search the indexes or go to one of the forty-two categories. Thus, if a fact about presidential elections is sought, that category might be consulted first. Categories range from, for example, the American Revolution, to cities and counties, Congress, monuments, political movements, advocacy groups, public welfare (subdivided prolifically), women, and many more. Broad categories are subdivided yet again.

Even print volumes like this have a place in our digital age, and leafing through this volume reminds one just how delightful serendipity can be when held in the palm of your hand."
