

"Touted by its publisher as a work "by librarians for librarians," Fiction Core Collection is one of H. W. Wilson's comprehensive "shortlist[s] of the essential books in a given category." Other Core Collections cover nonfiction titles, graphic novels, young adult books, etc. This mammoth work—an abridged print version of the corresponding Core Collection database hosted by EBSCOhost—lists **8,500 popular works of fiction**. A preface outlining its scope, purpose, and organization is followed by a **helpful guide to using the book**, which is divided into two parts. Part one lists the fictional works alphabetically by author, with brief annotations; part two provides indexes by name, title, and subject. Entries in part one include full bibliographic information, Library of Congress call numbers, and award designations. Most also include two notes: a summary of the book and an excerpt of a review from a prominent source, such as The New York Times Book Review, Library Journal, or Kirkus. Many entries include additional information, like the fact that a book is a sequel or features a bibliography. The "most highly recommended" titles are helpfully flagged with a star. The annotations and indexes make the book a versatile resource, readily navigable by **course-planning professors and librarians alike.** It might be particularly useful as a complement to the *Nonfiction Core* Collection, which highlights relevant critical, historical and biographical resources."
