

"This volume updates the first edition, published in 1985. Nearly six hundred entries, written by eighty-six contributors, cover thirty-one areas of reform, such as abolition, education, labor unions, Native American rights, prison reform, and suffrage. The reformers presented here range from well-known individuals such as Jane Addams, John Brown, Mark Twain, Thomas Jefferson, and Martin Luther King, to little-known people who in fact changed the course of American history in their various ways. The new edition has added two categories: LGBTQ and conservative reformers. Among those additions are Harvey Milk, Patrick Buchanan, and Phyllis Schlafly. Entries run from a page to three plus pages... Many entries include images (photos or paintings), mainly found in the Library of Congress.

...The newly added entries, of course, have many recent book, periodical, and even film references. Interestingly, the table of contents uses more complete names of many of the individuals, compared to the contents in the first edition, by adding middle and maiden names.

This volume does, however, provide excellent introductory information on hundreds of Americans who shaped numerous aspects of this country's history. Academic and public libraries seeking a wide-ranging biographical resource for this group of important Americans will be well-served..."
