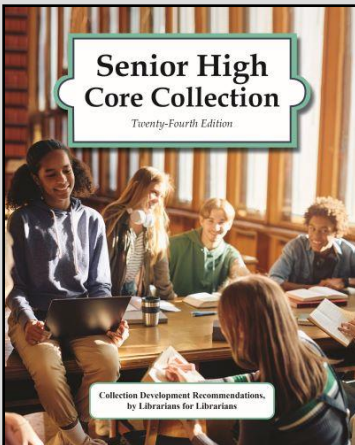


# Senior High Core Collection

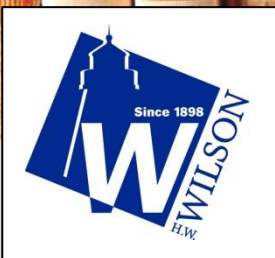

“Wilson’s Core Collection series are standard collection management tools for school and public libraries. They are now also available online in Ebscohost as a database which is updated weekly and includes expanded content such as additional metadata, reviews, and “Supplementary” and “Archival Materials.” The printed version, continuing to be updated every two years, covers “Most Highly Recommended” and “Core Collection” titles. This edition covers **over 8,600 titles**, including an expanded professional aids section (bibliographies and selection & evaluation resources, library management and programming, library building design, and use of the Internet in instruction); significant revisions in the computers and STEM sections; and graphic novels. The volume excludes most non-English titles, adult fiction not widely read or used in curricula for senior high students, computer program manuals, topics that date quickly, and “classic literature,” leaving greater emphasis on current and less easily identified materials. Part one is the classified section, arranged by the abridged Dewey classification and followed by fiction and short story collections. Part two is the author, title, and subject index. **The use of Dewey and Sears headings makes this an easily navigable resource.** The editors and 11 Advisory Board members have put together an edition **worthy of the history of this resource**; it continues to be an **essential resource for collection management in high school and public libraries.** Librarians will want to consider the database for access to greater numbers of titles and resources. **Essential.**”
